Mats began practising aikido in 1997 in Sweden with Jorma Lyly and soon after with Jan Nevelius shihan who both remain his teachers to the present day. His main influence outside of Sweden is Christian Tissier shihan, and Christian's close student Fabrice Croizé helped him to further deepen his understanding of the art.

In aikido, Mats' focus is on reducing movements to their essence of simplicity. He strives to both understand and challenge existing patterns in order to create stillness, clarity, and sharpness. For him it is important to remove the "ego" from our practice so that we can learn to develop the right kind of "positive" power, creating aikido that despite its sharpness remains connected and peaceful.

"Aikido has been the one thing that unites me with the most beautiful parts in myself, and having the chance to share this inspiration with other people is one of the greatest gifts in life", says Mats.

Mats hold the 4th dan Aikikai and teaches at Vanadis Aikidoklubb in Stockholm.
